

Enrichment Classes

Would you like to extend your child's day or add an additional day? Below please read about our enrichment classes that are offered. All enrichment classes do not require parent participation. Each class is staffed by a Teacher and Assistant Teacher. Below you will find the class descriptions along with the days and times these classes are offered.

Terrific Threes:

This Enrichment class is offered to children enrolled in a 3 year old class. This class meets on Monday from 12:30 – 3:00. This is a literature based program in which children expand a piece of children's literature in to the areas of art, music, theater and pretend play. This class is excellent for developing language skills in our younger students.

Fabulous Fours:

This enrichment class is offered to children enrolled in a 4 year old class and Kindergarten Enrichment. Fabulous Fours is an exciting class which travels around the world to different countries. Children will learn about the geography, customs, language, music, food, art and resources of a country. They will read literature from the country as well as make art projects and sometimes food that is associated with the region. Fabulous Fours is a wonderful way to sample the many cultures of the world and have fun doing it. This class is offered on Friday Mornings from 9:00 – 11:30 or on Monday afternoons from 12:30 – 3:00.

Science 123:

This Enrichment class is offered to children enrolled in both the 3 and 4 year old morning classes. This class meets on Tuesday from 11:30 – 2:00. Children will bring a lunch and have recess prior to the enrichment class. This class takes advantage of a child's natural curiosity about the world around them and introduces science and math skills in a developmentally appropriate way. Children will explore animals, earth science, weather, and health using observation, graphing, counting and measurement.

Top Chefs:

This enrichment class is offered to children in 3s, 4s and KE. The class takes place Wednesday mornings from 9:30 – 12:30 or Wednesday afternoons from 11:30 to 2:30. This is a cooking class based on children's literature. Children will cook a dish that relates to a popular children's story. They will read a story such as the Apple Pie Tree and make mini apple pies or The Littlest Pilgrim and make a casserole. The children will learn about nutrition and the food groups. They will also learn cooking terms, techniques, table setting, and table manners. Please be sure to pack a lunch. This will be a "nut free" class but as it is a cooking class it is not recommended for children with multiple allergies.

Dutch Neck Players:

This enrichment class is offered to children enrolled in both 3 and 4 year old morning classes. This class meets on Thursday from 11:30 – 2:00. Children will have a lunch and recess at school followed by the enrichment class. This class will explore popular children's literature and recreate it within the realm of theater, music and movement. Children will create scenery, costumes and choreography to bring favorite stories to life.

Lunch Bunch:

A one-hour class offered 11:30 to 12:30 where students have lunch together. Each session will include activities, stories and outdoor play.
